Regular Board Meeting
05/04/2022

Minutes from the 04-06-2022 Board Meetings:

Meeting was called to order at 7:01 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance. Those in attendance were the following: Supervisors: Dave Leslie, Ron Pittman, and Loy Adkins, Clerk Angela Koski, Treasurer Diane Jacobson, Kip Borbiconi, Trent Vanderhoof, Art Peterson, and Jay Asuma.

The regular board meeting was put on hold so that the reorganization meeting could take place. Before the reorganization meeting began, the floor was given to the guests. Three community parents had come to the meeting to ask the board members to consider making a donation to the newly reorganized baseball program. Cherry and Clinton Townships would now have combined teams. The guests were Trent Vanderhoof, Art Peterson, and Jay Asuma. There will be 3 T-Ball teams, 2 Coach Pitched teams, 2-10U teams, 2-12U teams, and 1 Babe Ruth team. These dads asked for a donation for jerseys, hats, balls, etc. for the new program.

Ron gave a brief explanation of the history and struggles for donations between the two communities. Board members explained that they will gladly support the new program. However, they would need to bring specific details such as what will be purchased, where these purchases will be stored, etc. Cherry Baseball will turn over the funds that are in their bank account and the signs that businesses have on the fences to help support the program once both communities open a new joint bank account for the new program. Once the program leaders can provide the requested information they should contact Ron Pittman who will then contact the other board members or he will present it at the next board meeting for discussion and a donation (if answers to questions have been provided) will be made.

Some things that were known about the new baseball organization at this time included:

- No league fees at this time.
- There will be Tournament fees
- League will cover insurance similar to what St. Louis County Little League has done in the past.

Once the baseball discussion was complete, we conducted the annual reorganization meeting. See attached minutes from that meeting.

At the conclusion of the Annual Reorganization meeting, the regular monthly meeting began.
